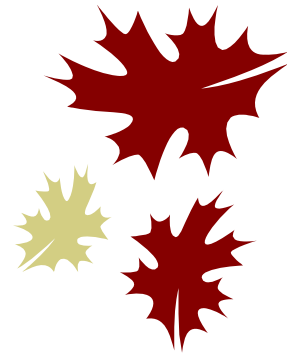


Sea Pines Community Center Fall Events

Complete the flu shot consent form and bring it to your appointment. The form is available at the CSA Office and on-line at www.hiltonheadregional.com.

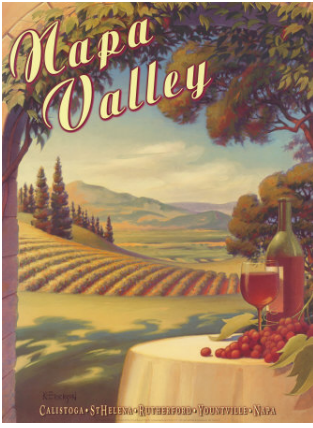
Medicare recipients must bring their Medicare card and a photo ID
